## WHAT?

Elementary level (A1.1) course for the German language.

# About the course

The A1.1 course is designed for literate children between 8 and 10 years without prior or little German knowledge.

In 6 modules, children will be introduced to the German language. Each module lasts 4 weeks (40mins/week) and can be booked separately.

The course outline is based on the structure of a book for German as a foreign language.

## MODULE 1

Introduction to the sound of the German language, animal names and the German alphabet.

## MODULE 2

Introducing ourselves and others, asking each other how we are. Other basics like colors, body parts etc.

## MODULE 3

Speaking about hobbies and things we like to do, counting to 10.

## MODULE 4

Learning about family members and speaking about them, counting to 20.

## MODULE 5

Saying where we come from and how old we are, counting to 100.


## MODULE 6

Speaking about school supplies, describing things with colors and characteristics.

## MODULES 7-12

After completion of the A1.1 course, children may continue with the A1.2 course, which covers modules 7 to 12.

With the two courses, children will be able to reach German level A1 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).
